Dear Parents,

I'm so happy to be able to tell you that Westchester County will be continuing to sponsor a remote learning center for the children of essential workers at the New Rochelle YMCA, starting on Monday, February 22nd.

The program will be running from 8:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. every weekday, and will follow the New Rochelle school calendar. The program will end on June 26th.

The children will be screened every day and will have their temperatures taken twice daily. Parents will be expected to be present during drop off and stay until their children have been cleared to enter the building.

Each child is expected to wear a mask and cannot attend the program if they are exhibiting signs of illness. The children need to bring an approved electronic device with them in order to complete their schoolwork. The device must have parental controls already installed on it.

We are not providing lunch, but ask that any food that you send in with the children be nut and seed free.

We ask that you pick your children up in a timely manner and that if you are going to be late, you call the Y to let staff know.

During this challenging time, Westchester County is happy to be able to support organizations, like the New Rochelle YMCA, as well as the front line workers who are continuing to help us through this crisis.
